### ANNUAL REPORT (2023-24) DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY S.D.M.GOVT.P.G.COLLEGE DOIWALA

The Department of psychology was established in 2001. The Department was upgraded into a postgraduate department in 2017 with 02 students in M.A taking admission in the course. Presently, the dept. of psychology has made efforts to achieve its program outcomes. The departmental progress in 2023-24 is as follows:

### 1) Curricular Aspects:

- Regular departmental meetings were conducted.

- The dept. incorporated tutorials for the identified slow learners. A visit to the dept. of clinical psychology, Swami Ram Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Jolly Grant was organized for the advanced learners where, they attended an expert lecture.

- 2 students progressed to pursue post graduation, total 04 students found placement after completion of post graduation and 01 student got selected for diploma in clinical psychology (RCI recognized) from dept. of clinical psychology, Swami Ram Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Jolly Grant.
