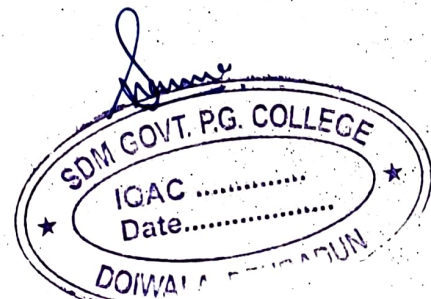


Feedback Analysis Report 2022-23

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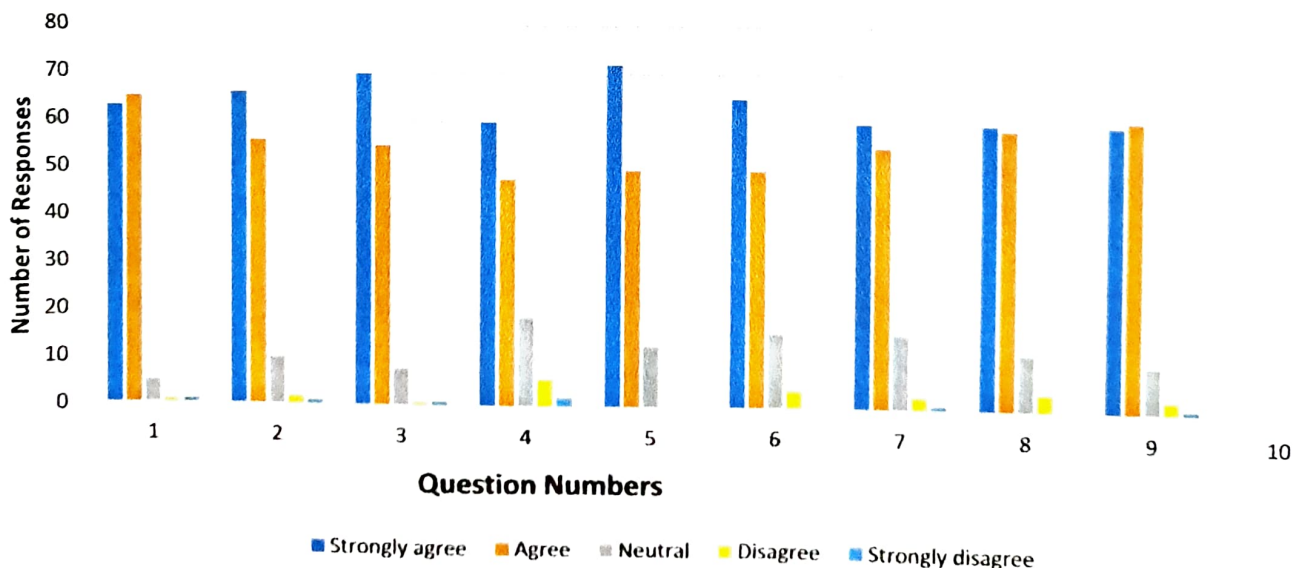
Student's Feedback analysis –

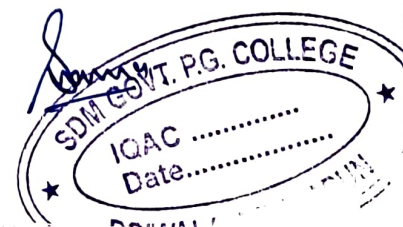

Chart-1: Students Feedback on Curriculum




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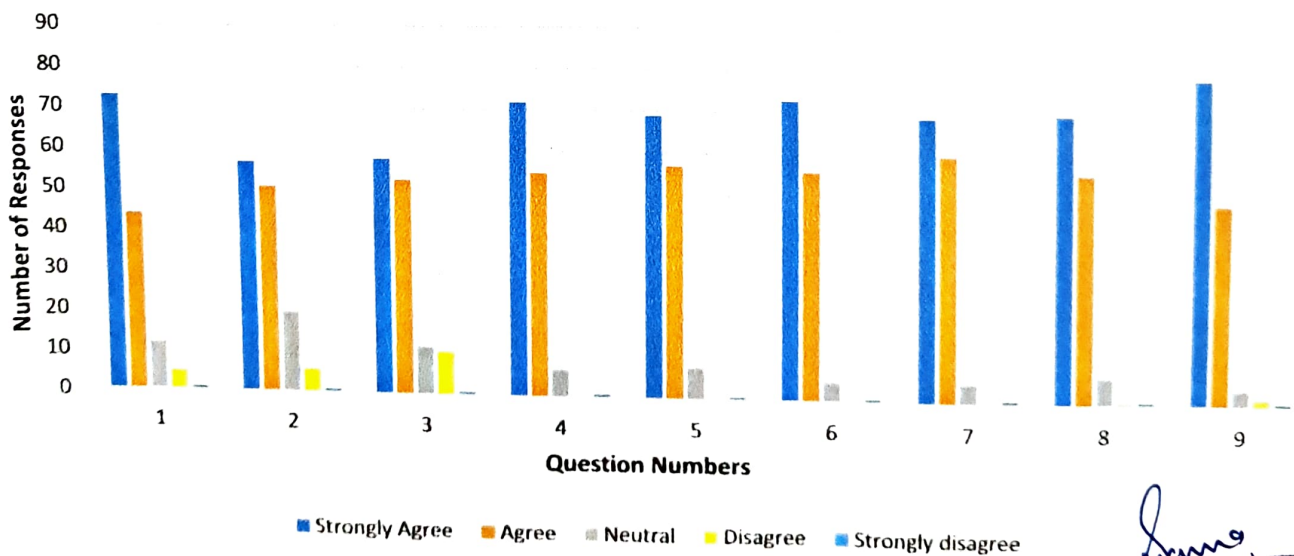

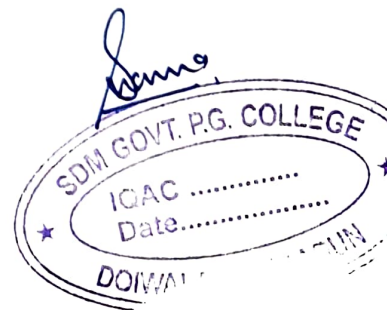

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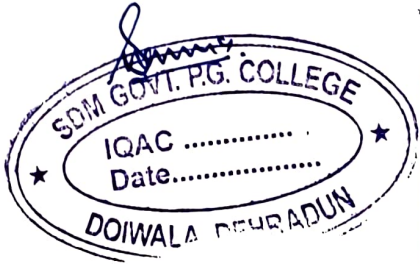
Student's Feedback analysis summary:

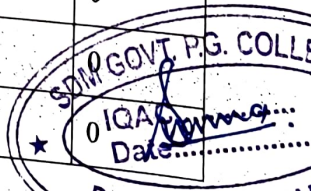

Chart-4: Teachers Feedback -- Curriculum

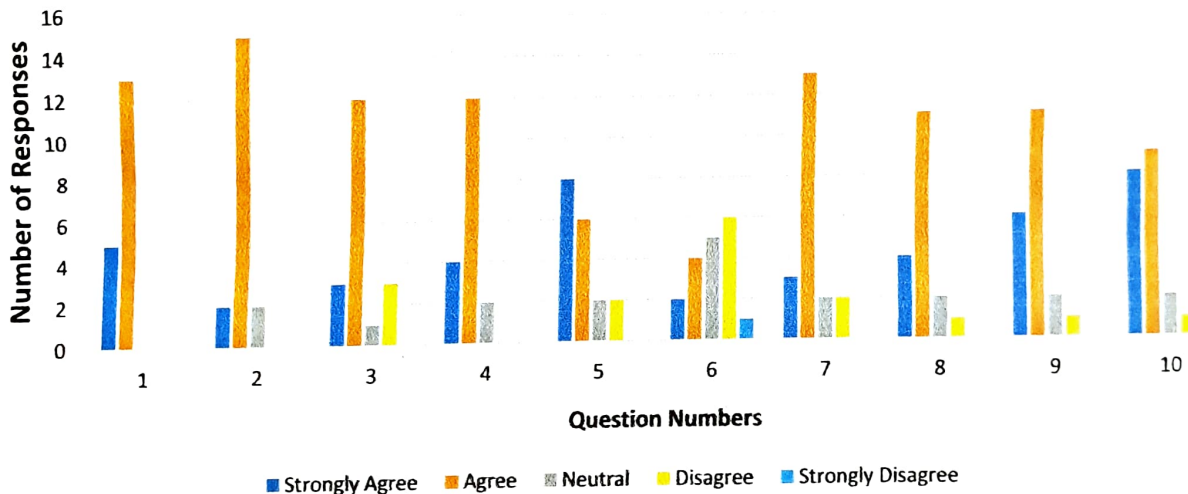
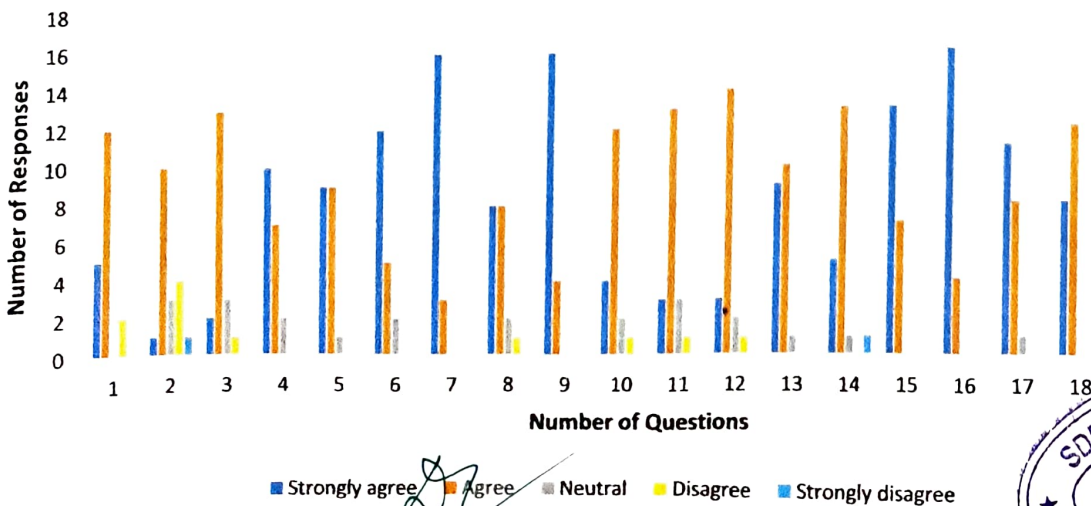
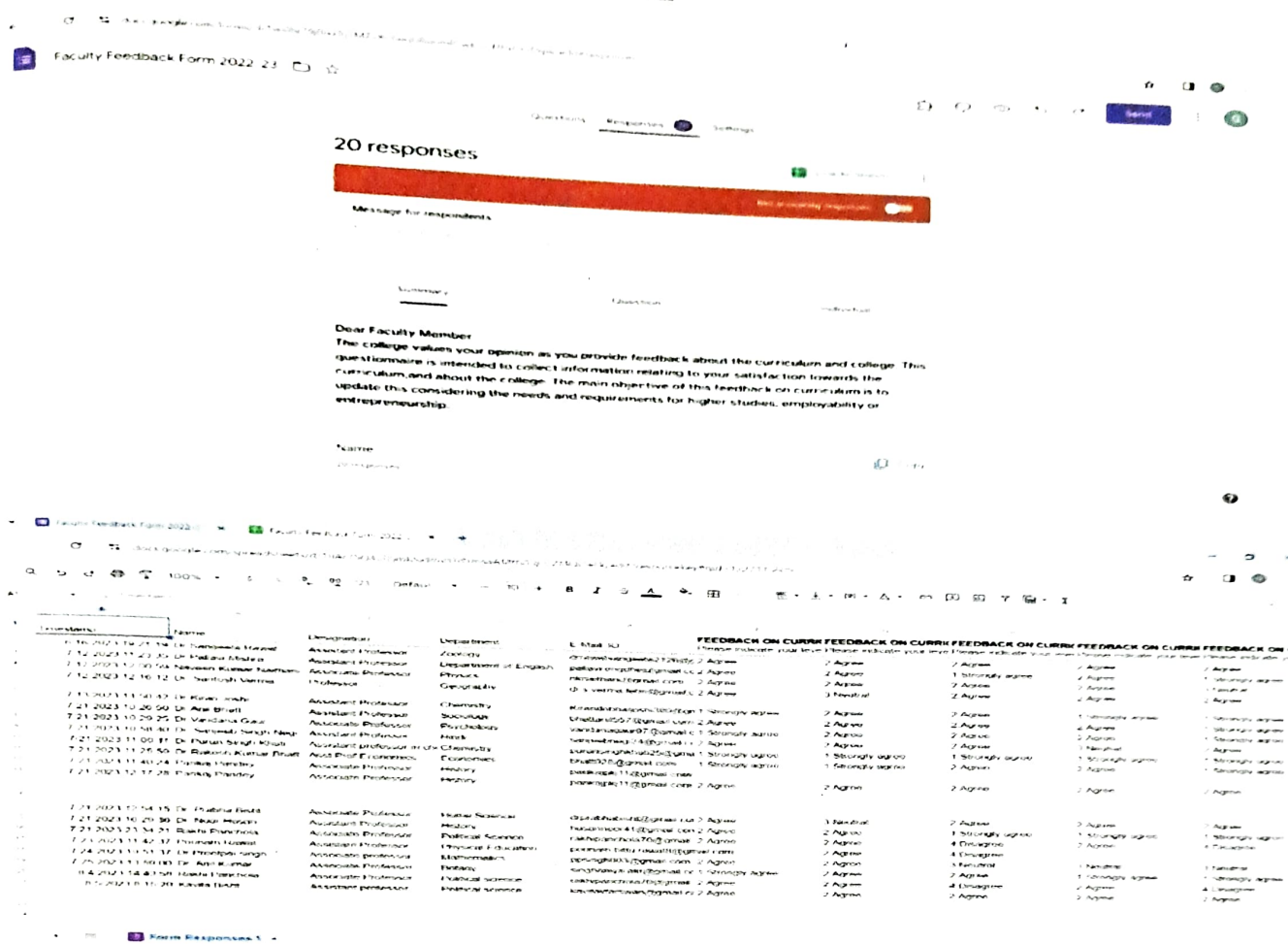


Chart-5: Teachers Feedback -- Infrastructure

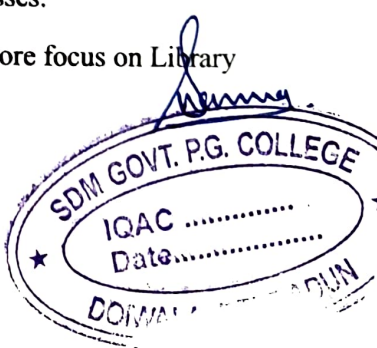
Teacher's Feedback analysis summary :

- There should be more learning resources especially E-resources for students and teachers. More focus on Library facilities and books.

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


Alumni Feedback Analysis:

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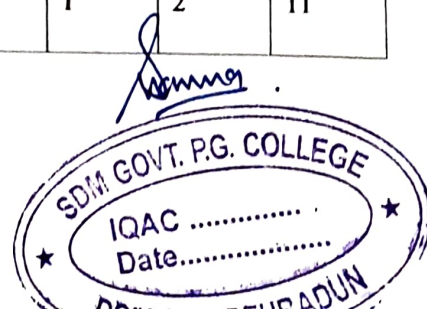
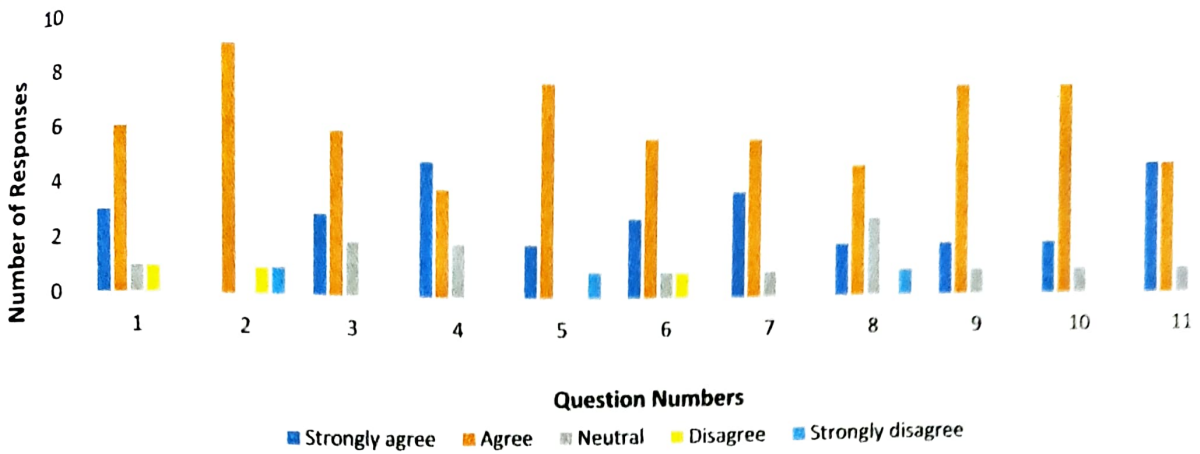


Chart-6: Alumni Feedback - Curriculum and infrastructure

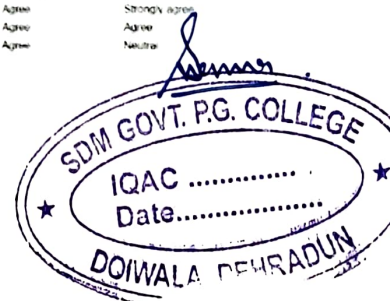

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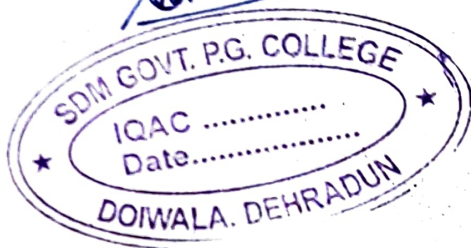
Alumni Feedback analysis summary:

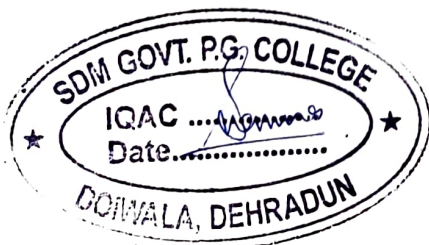
