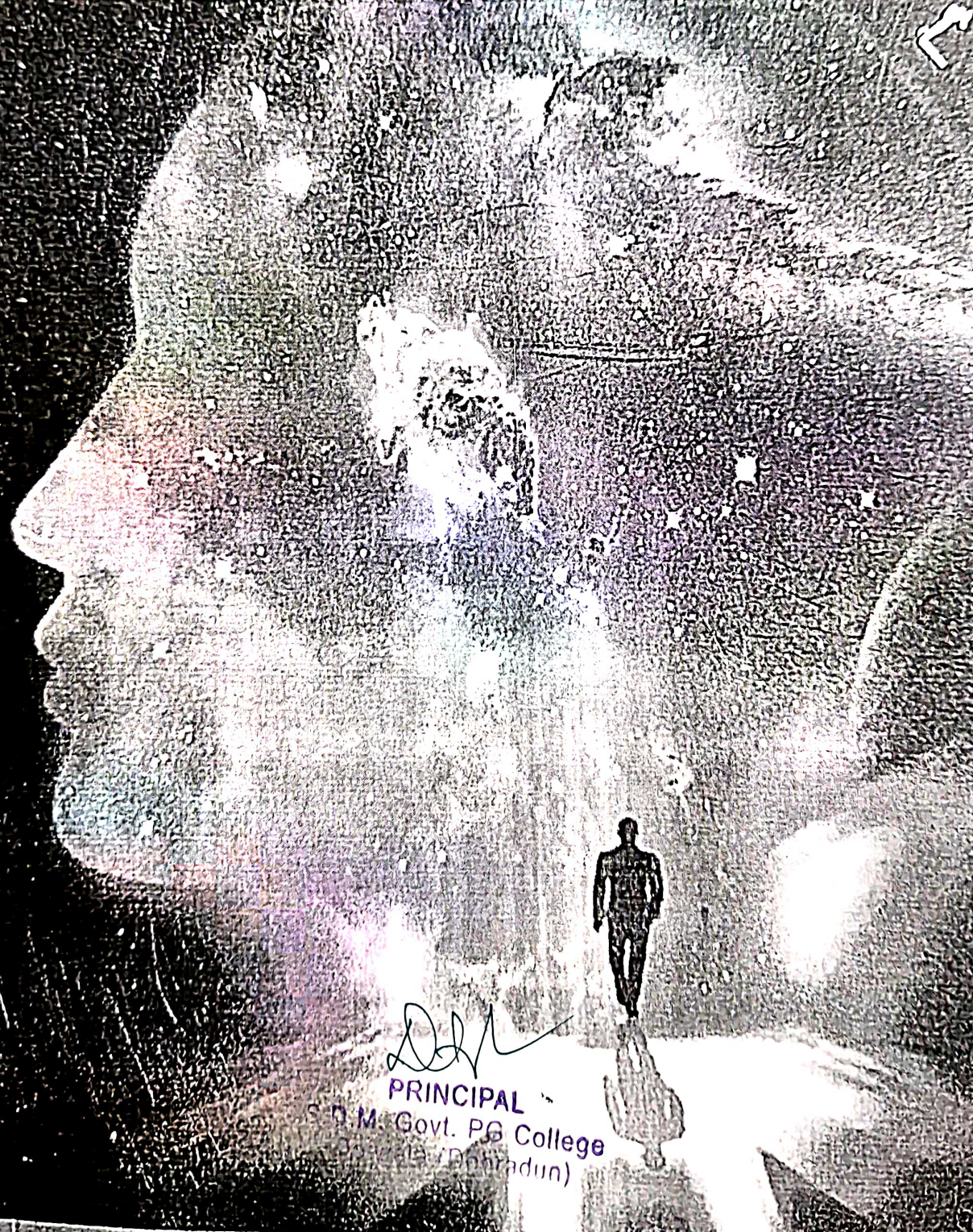

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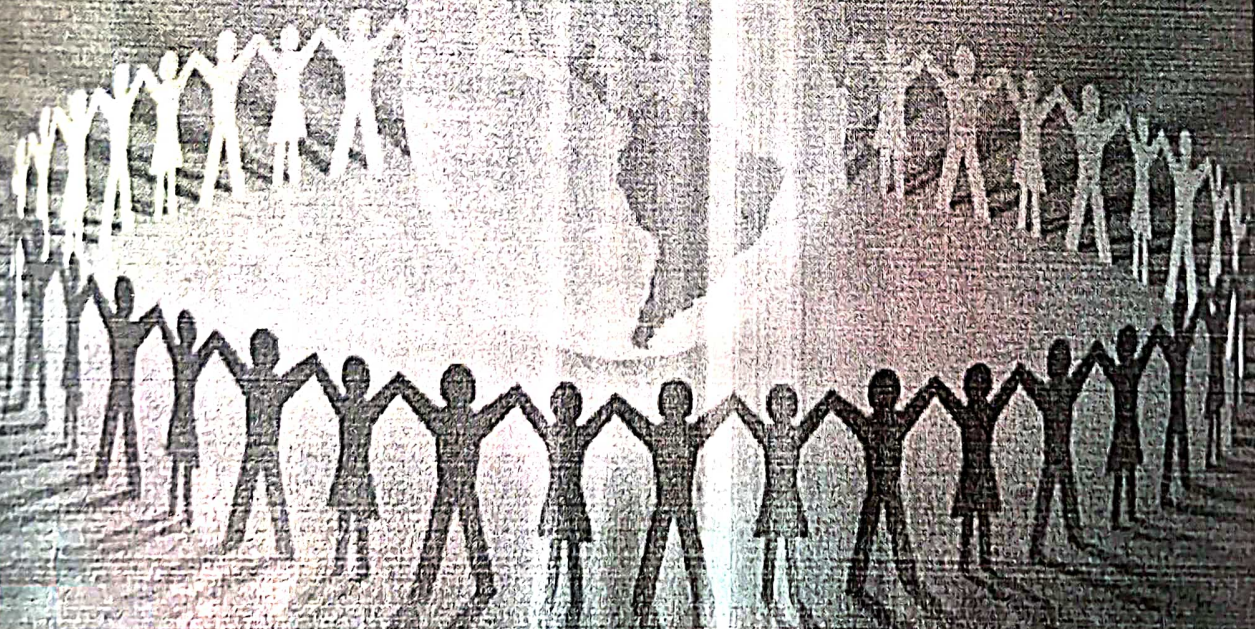

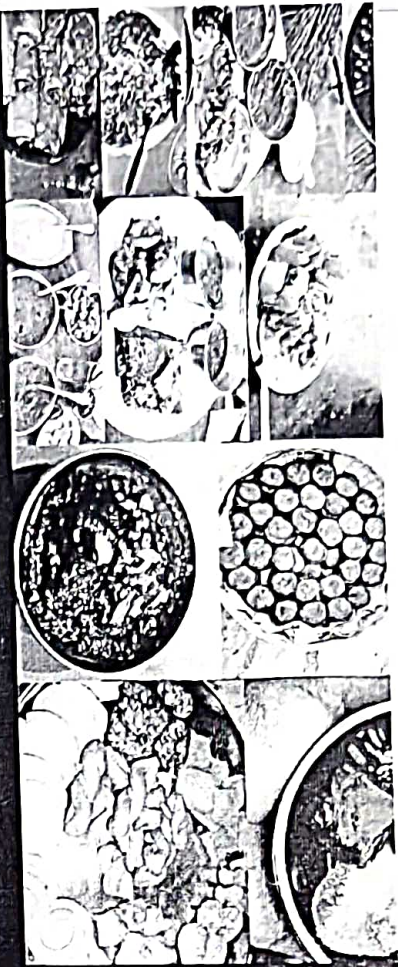

Introduction

Vocational Education is any type of training, usually in the form of course and hands on instructional lessons that teach students the specialized skills required for performing a specific job. These types of programmes usually forgo traditional academic based lessons in favor of hands on learning. Students learn the fundamentals and capabilities of a specific occupation under the supervision of an active and highly experienced professional.¹ Vocationalization of education has helped utilizing and managing resources that decide the growth and development of any nation. Seeing the current scenario the integration of vocational education with general education is being proposed under the New Education Policy, India has an important window of demographic dividend opportunity from about 2005-2006

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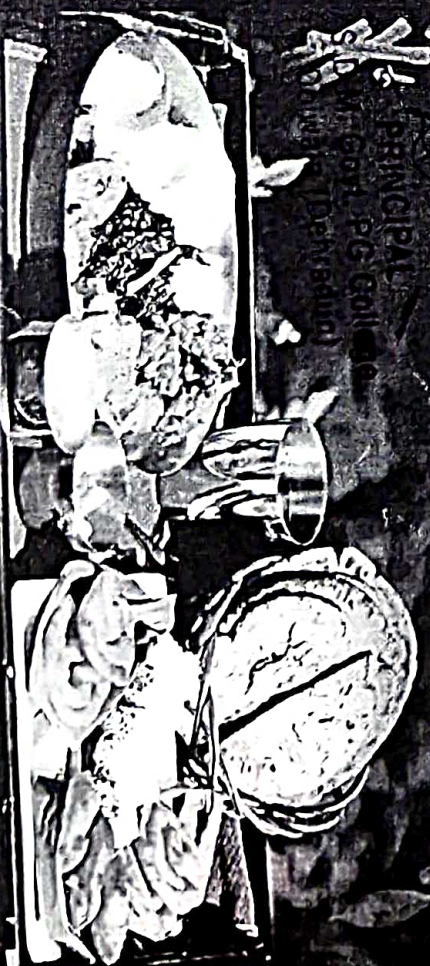
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
